Please read all the information here carefully before applying. Consider your abilities, interests, and how much time you'll have next year to devote to WIQH. ALL managers will have to start next year 'Academically Eligible' (by the CCHS official definition) and remain so throughout the year. Then pay attention to the following dates and deadlines:

Monday, May 7: Applications due by 6:00PM

(return to Ned Roos)

Monday, May 16(tentative): Next year's managers announced, with transition

to the new managers starting immediately.

## **General Information About WIQH Management**

This is serious. These are serious and important jobs. If you're not applying because you really want to do the work, then think twice about it. If what you're trying to do is pad a college application, you won't succeed with an IQH management position; you have to want to do it because you want to help the station.

You will be expected to do everything listed below...and more. It takes time and a FULL-YEAR commitment. You will need to do radio work at times when you'd rather be doing other stuff but you're going to have to adjust your schedule to fit what needs to be done at the station. If you're not willing to do that, then think twice about being a manager. You'll be:

- attending (every other week at the moment) manager meetings
- helping with the administrative duties of running the station, like preparing show logs, planning and coordinating events
- helping to supervise the station's operation (that means you should expect to be 'on duty' at the station certain broadcast hours above and beyond a show each week)
- training other station members in all aspects of the radio station's operation
- pitching in above and beyond most other members
- brainstorming ways to improve the station

If you've been on a sports team, then you know a little about what it's like. In sports, you either show up for practice or you're off the team. And you show up at practice whenever practice is, regardless of whether it's convenient for you or not. WIQH management is a bit more forgiving but not a whole lot. Why? Because the station relies on *you* to keep it running.

If you have questions about what position might be best for you or whether you could do a good job as a WIQH manager, ask a current manager or talk with Ned before you apply.
